# GENERAL CLUB POLICIES

## Main Office/Accounting

## Membership Dues

Annual membership dues are paid in full by March 15, 2025. All dues are non-refundable and non-transferable. Membership Dues will not be pro-rated throughout the term of the membership.

## Member Charges/Credit Privileges

Members are accountable for all charges to their individual Member accounts. Purchases in all areas including the restaurant, lounge, concession stand, and Pro Shop may be either charged to one's Member account or paid for in cash or credit at time of sale. When charging, members are asked to sign all member charge slips; no adjustments will be made for unsigned chits. Charging privileges will be suspended if your member account is not in good standing.

## Billing Errors

The office will investigate any suspected error on a member account upon notification of discrepancy. We highly suggest members view their accounts regularly. Questions regarding your monthly statement should be addressed immediately to the Club accounting office at 508-865-4441 ext. 305 or [isabellemarie@pleasantvalleycc.com](mailto:isabellemarie@pleasantvalleycc.com).

## Payments

Statements are mailed/emailed during the first five business days of the month. Payments must be received in full by the office by the 20th of that month to avoid late fees. Balances are not allowed to be carried over. All accounts that are ten (10) days past due will be subject to a \$100 late fee. Any account thirty days (30) days past due are subject to privileges being suspended. Cash, check or credit cards are acceptable forms of payment. Credit card payments can be made through the member portal and applicable CC processing fees will apply. Checks made payable to Galaxy Links, LLC, 95 Armsby Road, Sutton, MA 01590. There will be a fee of \$50 for any check returned by the bank. On-line payment via Jonas E-Payment Services may be made from your checking or savings account or via Credit Card. Payments via the member portal can be scheduled in advance or a recurring payment set-up. A recurring payment will charge whatever balance is on your account on the day you set up the draw. The payment portal is a third-party payment processor, we do not have access to your banking information and any changes are the member's responsibility. To access the member payment portal: log into the website at [www.pleasantvalleycc.com](http://www.pleasantvalleycc.com) go to Members tab, then to Member Login.

## Food Assessment

All members are subject to a \$150 monthly food minimum between April and November each year. Members who have a shorter stay with us have the option to choose a 5, 6 or 7-month higher monthly minimum. It is the members responsibility to let the accounting office know in advance if they would like an alternative plan. Changes will not be made after April 1, 2025.

- Member food in Champions including take-out, concession and beverage cart apply towards Monthly Food Minimum.
- Any unused food minimum at the end of the month is posted to your account and are due.
- Alcoholic beverages do not count toward the Monthly Food Minimum
- Member Events do not count towards the Monthly Food Minimum. This includes Easter & Mother's Day brunch, wine dinner, tournaments, and Member Guests events.

Breakdown of Plans:

8 Month, April—November: \$150/month

7 Month, May—November: \$171.43/month

6 Month, May—October: \$200.00/month

5 Month, June—October: \$240.00/month

## Dress Code

Pleasant Valley Country Club depends on its members to conduct themselves in a courteous manner towards other members and Pleasant Valley staff. We also depend on our members to dress in good taste.

On the golf course and practice facilities—Gentleman must wear appropriate golf attire. Slacks and shorts of sufficient length are permissible. T-shirts, tank tops, pool attire gym shorts, short shorts, cutoffs, denim, and tattered clothing are considered inappropriate apparel for the golf course and may not be worn. Caps must be worn forward.

For women, shorts and skirts must be of sufficient length.

In the Clubhouse/Champions Restaurant—Proper dress is required at all times in clubhouse / restaurant. Denim jeans are allowed, however jeans with any holes or rips are not permitted. Hats are not permitted in Champions Restaurant, except for women, who may wear hats.

**Members are asked to advise their guests of the Club's dress code.**

## Cell Phones

Cell phones/tablets must be on vibrate or silence on the course and in dining areas. If you must use your phone, please refrain from using it at your table and proceed to someplace away from other members.

## Parking

Members and their guests must park their cars in the parking spaces designated by the Club. No member may park their car in front of the Clubhouse, this area is designated as a fire lane. The Club is not responsible for cars, or contents therein, or any other personal property on the Club premises.

## Smoking & Marijuana

Vaping, cigarette, or cigar smoking is prohibited inside the entire Clubhouse as well as the patio or pool area. Smoking and "vaping" of tobacco products are allowed outdoors only in designated areas. All smoking materials should be discarded properly in a trash receptacle, this includes on the golf course.

The smoking of marijuana or usage of any product that contains THC (e.g., "vape pens", "edibles", etc.) is prohibited anywhere on Club property.

## Language

Profanity is prohibited on Club property. Members bring family, friends, and clients and should never be subject to hearing vulgarities while enjoying the Club.

## Champions Restaurant

Reservations are highly recommended and appreciated, especially for the busy nights in the restaurant and patio. The reservations not only ensure a table, but it also helps Management staff properly in both the front and back of the house. Please call Champions Restaurant at (508) 865-5785 for reservations.

When charging to your account, we ask that all members sign their charge slips. Members also have the opportunity to add a gratuity to the check. Please note that a 20% gratuity is automatically added to all Champions/Cart/Concession checks unless signed.

Food, alcohol, and non-alcoholic beverages not purchased at the Club may not be consumed on Club property. Members may not bring their own wine or liquor to accompany meals.

The sale and consumption of alcoholic beverages shall be in accordance with the applicable laws and regulations of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts. The staff is required to refuse service to any minor less than 21 years of age and to terminate the service of alcoholic beverages to any person who has or appears to be intoxicated. All management's decisions in this regard are final.

## PV Health & Fitness Center

The Fitness Center opens April 1st, Tuesday - Sunday. Hours of operation will be posted and can change throughout the season. The Fitness Center is closed on Mondays.

- All members must sign-in at the desk as you enter the fitness center.
- Guests of members using the fitness center must sign-in as well and the appropriate guest fee will apply. Member must be present with their guests.
- Children under the age of 16 are prohibited from using the equipment unattended by an adult.
- Wipe all equipment after each use and place weights and equipment back in proper location.
- Proper fitness attire is required, including shirts and athletic shoes.
- Read equipment instructions prior to use and abide by such instructions.
- No Alcoholic beverages or glassware are allowed in our Fitness Center at any time.
- Remove all personal articles upon completion of workout.

## Pool

The pool is open Tuesday - Sunday, Memorial Day through Labor Day pending permitting per the Sutton Board of Health. The hours of operation will be posted and can change throughout the season. The Pool is closed on Mondays.

- All members must sign-in at the desk as you enter the Fitness Center.
- Members of the Club may invite guests to join them at the pool provided that the guest is registered, and the appropriate guest fee will be charged to the members' account.
- No lifeguard is on duty at the pool, swim at your own risk. All persons using the pool or pool area shall be responsible for their own safety and shall be deemed to have assumed the risk of using the pool or pool area.
- Persons are not permitted in the pool if they have a cold, fever, infection of any kind, skin rash, inflamed eye(s), or are wearing bandages.
- Children under the age of 16 cannot use the swimming pool without an adult in attendance.
- Non-swimmers may use life-guard-approved flotation devices but must remain in the shallow end of the pool.
- Showers are required before entering any pool.
- Radios, tablets, cell phones, and similar electronic devices may be listened to through the use of headphones or earbuds.
- Glass bottles, drinking glasses, and sharp objects are not permitted in the pool areas.
- Lifesaving and pool cleaning equipment should be used only for the purposes intended.
- Running, wrestling, diving, pushing, dunking, noisy or other hazardous activity will not be permitted in the pool area.
- Children that are not toilet trained must wear swim diapers.



## Rules Violations/Anti-Sexual Harassment Policy

Club employees, fellow Members and guests are to be treated with dignity and respect. Any conduct, whether verbal, physical, visual, or otherwise, that could be considered offensive, or intimidating will not be tolerated. Harassment based on race, religion, color, national origin, ancestry, gender, disability, marital status, or any other personal characteristics is not condoned nor will be tolerated by the Club.

Members must exercise their own good judgment to avoid engaging in conduct that may be perceived by others as sexual harassment. The following are illustrations of actions that are inappropriate:

- Unwelcome advances whether physical, verbal, or other with fellow members, guests, or PV employees.
- Sexual epithets, jokes, written or oral references to sexual conduct, gossip regarding one's sex life, comment on an individual's body, and comment about an individual's sexual activity, deficiencies, or prowess.
- Unwelcome leering, whistling, sexual gestures, suggestive or insulting comments.

Any member participating in such behavior will be brought before the Executive Committee for a hearing on the matter. The Executive Committee will be responsible for making a judgment on the matter and taking appropriate actions towards resolution. It is the responsibility of the Executive Committee to protect the Club against all possible legal ramifications of such behavior.

Any member disparaging the Club, fellow members or employees of the Club will be subject to review by the Executive Committee. Members conduct that is unbecoming of a member or detrimental to the Club may be subject to review; not limited to rules violation, bad language, hearsay, or malicious talk.

## Reporting of Violations

Any rules violation by a member will be documented, dated, and submitted to the Executive Committee. Any member wishing to make a complaint of any kind shall do so in writing to the General Manager or Head Golf Professional.

## Suspension of Membership

Rule's violations may be punishable by Membership suspension for the involved Member(s). These "suspension of privileges" may be levied for rule infractions of any Member and/or his/her guest(s), under the control of the Executive Committee.

Suspensions may be levied for conduct and rules violations which display a lack of concern for the golf course and its condition and/or the overall enjoyment of one's fellow Club Members.

The spirit of this system emanates from the concept that adherence to the rules is an enhancement to the Club and its Members and that any breakdown in adherence to the rules is detrimental to the Club and its Members.

## Executive Committee

The Executive Committee addresses, reviews and disciplines any inappropriate, harassing, detrimental or violent behavior exhibited by a Member. Discipline for such acts may include suspension of Club privileges or loss of membership.





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# GOLFING GUIDELINES

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*All guidelines are subject to change.*

All golfers must check in with the Pro Shop upon arrival to confirm tee time and partners as well as preference for walking, or riding cart. Appropriate fees will be applied.

No group will hold its place on the tee unless all its members are ready to play when called.

No personal coolers of any kind are allowed on golf cart or course.

**Pace of play must be observed as a courtesy to all members. Slower groups should always allow faster groups to play through. An 18-hole round for a foursome should be completed within 4 hours and 15 minutes.**

## Tee Time Policies

Tee times may be made seven (7) days prior to desired date through either the on-line tee sheet, phone or in person at the Pro Shop. Tee times are subject to availability based on leagues, clinics, groups, tournaments, and routine maintenance practices.

All members are responsible for knowing any restrictions that may apply to their membership categories related to tee times.

Single players may be paired up, as well as twosomes during peak play periods.

Restrictions to golf course usage on league nights (Tuesday & Fridays) are in effect, please see the Pro Shop for further details.

## Junior Golf Members (up to Age 22) Tee Time Policy

Junior Golf members may tee off AFTER 1:00 pm on weekends/holidays, and anytime weekdays, Tuesday - Friday. Single players will be paired up, as well as twosomes during peak play periods. All tee times are based on availability.

## Children Golf Members (7-15) Tee Time Policy

Children members may tee off AFTER 3:00 p.m. on weekends/holidays and BEFORE 11:00 a.m. on Fridays. Tuesday – Thursday is unrestricted during non-league times and based on availability. All children golf members must be accompanied by parent or guardian unless golf "etiquette" approved and certified by a PV Golf Professional.

## Guest Policy - Golf Course/Range

Guest fees are expected to be paid prior to teeing off by applying fees to the members account, or by cash/credit. Members are responsible for registering their guests in the Pro Shop.

Members must register their guests on the tee time reservation system or with the Pro Shop.

A guest may play only twice per calendar month and no more than eight times in a calendar year. IF a guest is invited to play in a member-guest tournament, this counts towards the twice per calendar month.

Guests are permitted on weekends/holidays after 12 PM and up to 3 guests are permitted on Fridays from 7:30 AM to 11:00 AM.

Members may invite up to three (3) guests to play at any one time.

A member with multiple guests (up to three) may play Tuesday – Thursday. Members may have more than three (3) guests upon special request but must contact the Pro Shop at least two weeks in advance. This request will only be honored during non-peak times.

Members may have up to four (4) unaccompanied guests, Tuesday – Thursday at the club's discretion.

The Club offers a preferential "house guest" policy when a member has a family member or friend staying at their house. Please contact the Pro Shop or General Manager to get approval for guest tee times.

Members are responsible for the conduct of their guests including adherence to Pleasant Valley Country Club policies regarding dress, golf course etiquette and cell phone use.

Guests of members can only use the range if they are playing the same day.

Same guest rules apply to the range as they do to the golf course.

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## Carts

Use of golf carts, both power and hand, is subject to daily permission from the Pro Shop and superintendent, and is primarily dependent on course and weather conditions.

Golf carts are required before 12:00 pm on weekends/holidays and for leagues and tournaments. Walking or using your own pushcart is permitted Tuesday – Friday and weekend afternoons, after 12:00 pm.

Only licensed drivers may operate golf carts.

A maximum of two carts per foursome is permitted. Any player requesting to take their own cart will be charged a double cart fee.

A cart should not be driven in muddy areas or through puddles of water or in any place that might injure the turf or native grasses.

Wherever possible, golf carts should remain on cart paths.

All members are responsible for the actions (cart rule violations) of any guest he/she brings to the Club.

The limit of two persons to a cart is to be observed and speed should be limited.

A golf cart should not be driven in wooded areas and never under low tree limbs.

The cart directional signs are to be observed at all times. **THIS IS A MUST!**

A golf cart should not be driven within 15 yards of any green unless a Handicap Flag is in use. Please contact the Pro Shop for rules regarding Handicap Flags on carts.

Golf carts must stop before crossing roads and may not be driven along public roads.

Carts are to be returned to the cart barn in the same condition they were received. Carts are not to be left in the parking lot or by Champions patio.

Operation of a golf cart in a dangerous or reckless manner will result in revocation of golf cart driving privileges.

Members and guests will be financially responsible for damage inflicted to the cart(s) during their time of rental.

## Trail Fees — Villa Homeowners

Pleasant Valley members that reside in the Villa's have the option to purchase a personal electric golf cart from the Club Car via the Pro Shop to be used on the property of Pleasant Valley. An annual trail fee is charged to the member in exchange for this privilege and it includes cart and pushcart usage. The trail fee does not cover guest riding in the member's cart at any time. All members owning their own golf cart must provide a current certificate of insurance and a signed trail fee agreement form before driving onto Pleasant Valley grounds. Carts are not allowed on Pleasant Valley grounds without insurance at any time. Members may not alter their personal golf cart.

## Walking Policy/Trail Fee

Walking or the use of a pushcart is permitted Tuesday-Thursday anytime, Fridays before 11:00 AM, and Saturdays & Sundays after 12:00 PM.

Anyone that requests to walk or use a pushcart during restricted times will be charged the full cart fee.

Walking is not permitted during any leagues or tournaments.

## Handicaps

Pleasant Valley utilizes the GHIN system and all scores must be posted in accordance with their regulations.

All handicaps shall be computed in accordance with the Regulations prescribed by the United States Golf Association and shall promulgate such other regulations as shall from time to time be deemed appropriate.

GHIN handicap is included with Full Membership. Associate and Weekday members may request a GHIN handicap for an additional fee.

## Practice Facility Rules and Regulations

Operating hours will be posted by Pro Shop and will be adjusted accordingly to season and inclement weather conditions.

Balls must be hit within designated ropes and chipping areas must be used appropriately.

For safety reasons, players with the distance to reach the last target flag may not use their driver on the range.

Limited member categories must observe the same restrictions for their category at the practice facility.

## General Tournament Guidelines

United States Golf Association Rules of Golf govern all tournament play unless superseded by local rules. Tournaments are posted at least two weeks prior to tournament event date. Please refer to "Tournaments" section of the Golf Guide for dates, formats, and entry fees. Please see Pro Shop staff with any questions.

All tournaments registrations will be concluded by the tournament deadline. The Executive Committee reserves the right to change, cancel or postpone any scheduled event. Rain dates will be announced when necessary unless otherwise noticed in the Official Schedule of Golf Events. The Tournament Committee shall set entry fees for all tournaments and announce the same as soon as practical.

All golfers MUST have an official handicap to be eligible for most tournaments.

The Golf Professional Staff, the Executive Committee, and official designees will make decisions on all questions pertaining to the "Rules of Golf."

Members can register for tournaments via the Pro Shop.



## Rules and Etiquette of Golf

The Rules of Golf as published annually by the United States Golf Association shall apply. Any modifying Local Rules shall be listed on Club bulletin boards.

All players are expected to replace turf, repair ball marks, smooth bunkers, and deposit all rubbish in receptacles.

Fill in divots made on tees with divot mix provided.

Practice on the golf course or regular greens is prohibited. Practice shall be strictly limited to the designated practice areas as well as the driving range.

Players shall keep golf bags and push carts off greens and out of bunkers.

Riding carts shall not be driven within fifteen yards of any green, obey all cart signs.

Slower groups and walkers should always allow faster groups to play through.

All players must be off the golf course and return carts to outside staff by sunset.

Cutting in is forbidden, always check in with the Pro Shop staff before teeing off.

Reports of violations of any golf rule or regulation must be made in writing and signed by the complaining member and submitted to a member of the Executive Committee. The report should be specific including time, date, and circumstances. If other members observed the violation, they should be asked to sign the letter noting the violation. The Committee at its discretion may hold a hearing on the alleged violation and make recommendations for appropriate sanctions, which could include a written warning or suspension of golf privileges.

The use of a speaker to play music while playing is allowed if used appropriately. Music must be played at a low enough level that allows only those in the cart to hear it. The volume level of the speaker should never be loud enough to disrupt another group. If members repeatedly cause a problem with playing music too loud, they will lose this privilege.





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# LEAGUES & CLINICS

Members in limited categories can participate  
in leagues if space is available.

## Tuesday Men's Twilight League

**START DATE:** Tuesday, May 13th

**TEAM INFO:** Teams may consist of two or three players. We strongly encourage having a three-man team and rotating each week in case someone cannot make it any given week. The cost is \$360.00 per team which will go towards weekly prizes for winners each week and playoff payouts. There will also be optional contests each week which include closest to the pin and net/gross skins. Cash must be paid to the Pro Shop for optional contests before teeing off each week.

**FORMAT:** Teams will be divided into divisions and will play match play style matches throughout the season. Matches will be played stroking off the lowest handicap player in the foursome. Scorecards must be turned into the Pro Shop at the completion of the match. Playoffs will begin immediately after the regular season. A club email will further detail the schedule.

## Thursday Ladies League

**START DATE:** Thursday, May 15th

**TEE TIMES:** From 8:45 AM to 9:30 AM

\*Teams unable to play in the designated Tee Times may play later in the day by contacting the Pro Shop in advance.

**FORMAT:** Two (2) Player teams, pick your partner.

Better ball for two from the red tees. \$10 entry fee per week per team. Your team can play 9 or 18 holes.



## Mixed Team Fridays

**START DATE:** Friday, May 9th

**TEAM INFO:** Teams consist of two (2) players. The cost is \$20 per week for team prizes and skins. Teams can make their own foursome week to week, but we strongly encourage playing with different couples as often as possible. We will assist in pairing any team in need of another foursome.

**FORMAT:** Tee Times from 4:00 PM until 5:00 PM. We will run varying nine-hole formats through the 19-week season. They will include Best Ball, Scramble and Bramble. On occasion, the Pro Shop will organize a four-player game.

**SIGN UP:** Each week by Thursday at 4 pm through the Pro Shop.

## Pro Tour Junior Clinics

**DATES:**

- April 22nd—April 25th (Tuesday - Friday)

Juniors will learn the basic rules of golf, proper etiquette, and swing techniques for all facets of the game. Instructors will focus on short game and full swing skills in a fun environment. The goal is to learn something new every day of the clinics while having fun and making new friends along the way. Snacks and water will be provided every day. All member's children or grandchildren are welcome to participate. If they want to bring a friend, that is allowed if space is available.
